RFP Process and Requirements

- Formal/structured RFP process
- RFP Evaluation Committee composition

- Insurance
- DBE is encouraged, but no requirement



RFP Process and Requirements, continued

- Proposer responsibilities:
 - Review the RFP
 - Ensure ALL required forms are signed and submitted
 - Incomplete proposal WILL NOT be forwarded to the Evaluation Committee for review

- Addendum No. 1 – summary of this meeting and responses to questions
- Resulting contract:
 - Fixed unit rate contract(s)
 - Submit a separate proposal for each beat
 - Three-year term, with two one-year options



RFP Process and Requirements, continued

- Minimum requirements:
 - Current and valid business license
 - 5 or more years experience operating a tow service
 - Contract with law enforcement agency
 - No FSP contract terminations
 - Compliance with the standard operating procedures (SOP)
 - Compliance with all laws governing a tow service business
- ***ALL*** of these requirements must be met for VCTC to review and evaluate your proposal!



RFP Process and Requirements, continued

- Myth: lowest price always wins – No! Price is 25% of your score
- Dedicated vehicles WHILE on the Beat
- Myth: can't use the FSP trucks post FSP service
- CHP oversight
- Rates/Price Form:
 - Rates are fixed for the duration of the contract
 - Incorporate potential increases in costs/inflation
 - Driver pay to and from beat and training
 - Proposers must use the Microsoft excel spreadsheet provided



RFP Process and Requirements, continued

Price Form Template:

- Download the Excel Spreadsheet from GoVentura.org
- Other forms will not be accepted
- Itemize costs by line item
- Form will calculate for you
- Except for profit
- Hourly rate, by year, calculated at the bottom
- Regular vs. CFSP rates

B.1 Detailed Itemized Price Form for Years 1 to 5 - Hourly Cost Breakdown for Beat 1

Beat 1 is 12.9 miles along U.S.-101, from Ventura/Los Angeles County line to Camarillo Springs Road
All hourly rate proposed costs are specific to the FSP Program ONLY. In F.1, F.2 and F.3, round to dollars (no cents).

RFP Process and Requirements, continued

- Submittal requirements:
 - Follow exact requirements outlined in Section II
 - Only hardcopy proposals will be accepted
 - NO fax or emailed proposals
 - Submit to Mr. Kent, at VCTC's address in Ventura
 - Clearly mark your proposal package as Beat 4
 - Proposals are due by **4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 6, 2023**
- Evaluation Criteria:
 - Contract awarded to most responsive/responsible proposer
 - Selection is based on demonstrated competence, qualifications, experience, capabilities and overall best value to perform the Scope of Work.

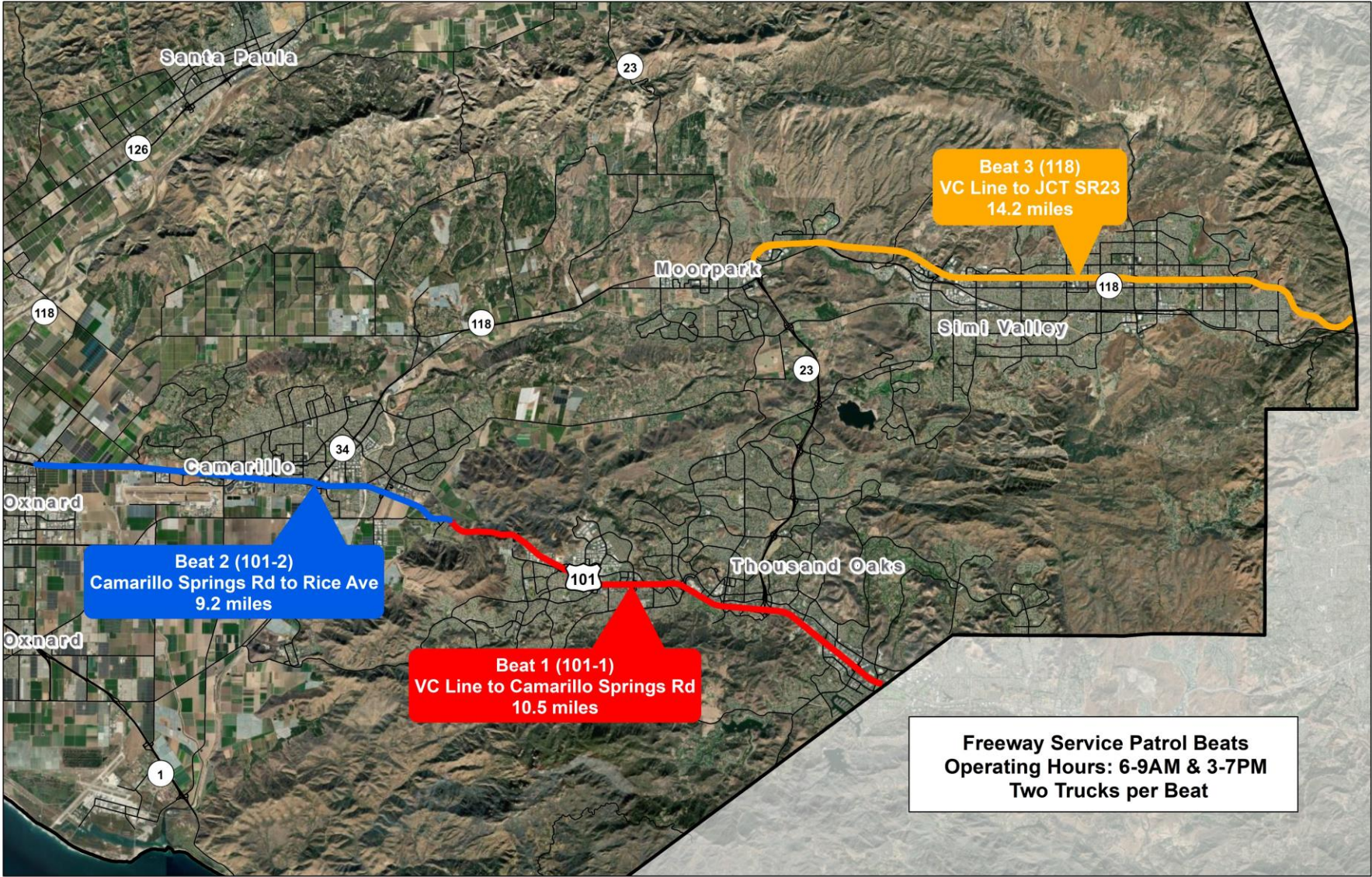


Scope of Work

- Beat 4 RFP is similar to the RFP used for Beats 1-3.
- Three-year contract term with a two-year option.
- Contractor must commit to patrolling Beat 4 Monday-Friday 6-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. with two trucks and maintain a backup truck.
- Contractor must be able to comply with Standard Operating Procedures, statewide guidelines, technology requirements and maintain good standing with law enforcement.
- Drivers must pass a background check, complete the FSP driver certification course and attend annual CHP trainings.

Scope of Work, continued

Types of FSP services provided:

- Jump starts
- Provide a gallon of gas
- Refill radiators
- Change a flat tire
- All services are at no charge to the motorist!
- 10 minutes per assist
- Tow to an approved drop point





Scope of Work, continued

Yard Location:

- Myth: only Ventura tow operators may propose - NO!
- However, must be in close proximity to the beat
- 45 minute requirement to be on the beat, if needed
- Penalties assessed if cannot comply

Tow Truck Requirements:

- Minimum Class A, GVWR of 14K lbs, dual wheel chassis and four ton recovery equipment rating
- < 1 year old with 50K max miles on chassis
- Seating for 5 adults
- Branding/paint limitations

Truck and Equipment Requirements – SOW, Section 4.0





Scope of Work, continued

Training requirements:

- Initial two-day training at LA CHP Southern Division offices
- Bi-annual refresher training
- Required for Drivers to attain and maintain FSP certification
- Include these costs in your price form

Contract Term:

- Contract/payment will begin on 1st day of FSP service
- Each Beat is for a three-year contract term
- At VCTC's discretion, may extend for additional two years



Scope of Work, continued

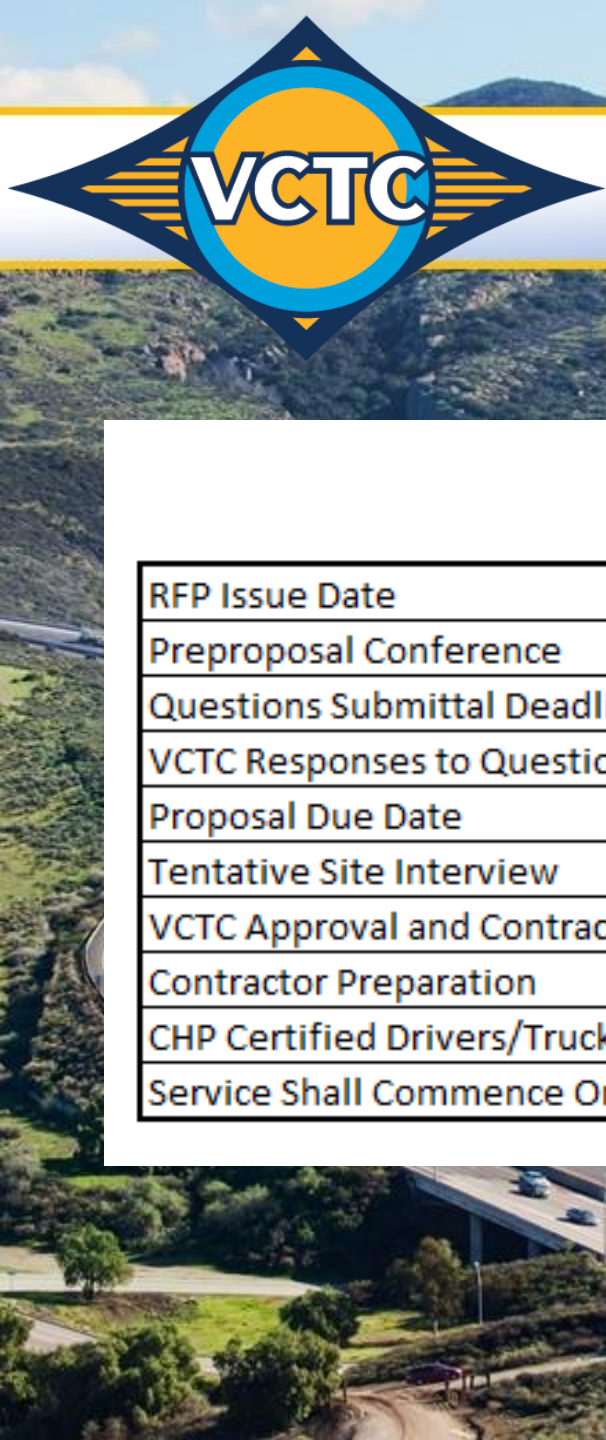
Additional Tips:

- VCTC/Caltrans/CHP want to review great proposals
- First time FSP Proposer? Seek out a winning proposal!
- Google other agency FSP RFPs
- ID the Board approval date and Proposer's name
- Follow the agency's public information request process
- There may be a fee and it takes time to send to you
- Will be well worth the effort!



Key Dates and RFP Deadlines

- Additional questions may be submitted via email by no later than Tuesday **November 23rd**, by 3:00 p.m.
- Responses to all questions and a summary of this conference will be posted on VCTC's website by **December 2nd, 2022**.
- Check the VCTC website often - may be additional Addenda
- Hardcopy proposals are due **January 6, 2023**, by 4:00 p.m.
- Interviews/site visits - **January 16th - 20th** – keep these dates open!
- VCTC will award contract(s) on Friday **February 3rd**
- Drivers/Trucks must be certified by CHP by **June 5th**
- Beats will commence on **July 3rd**
