

# UNMET TRANSIT NEEDS PUBLIC HEARING

Section 99401.5 of the California Public Utilities Code requires that at least one public hearing be held each year to receive testimony on whether there are areas in Ventura County with unmet transit needs which can be reasonably met through any of the following: expansion of existing transportation systems, establishing new systems, or contracting for service from common carriers and others, as provided by the

Transportation Development Act of 1971 (as amended).

Such a determination must be made before the Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) can allocate Transportation Development Act monies in Fiscal Year 2018/2019 for purposes other than transit. This determination will be made following a review of local and regional plans and the testimony received at the public hearing.
