

# "FIX IT FIRST" SB1 (BEALL)



### Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017

- SB 1 was passed by a two-thirds vote of both houses on April 6
- SB 1 can only be spent for transportation purposes
- Permanently increases fuel taxes and vehicle registration charges
- Provides an estimated \$52.4 billion of new revenues over 10 years





#### **SB 1 Funding Sources**

**Automatic Inflation Adjustment** 


- Gasoline Excise Tax: +12 cents per gallon
- **Diesel Fuel Excise Tax:** +20 cents per gallon
- Diesel Fuel Sales Tax: +4%
- Vehicle Registration Fee: +\$25-\$175 per year based on vehicle value
- Alternate-Fueled Vehicle Fee: New \$100 annual fee on alternate-fueled vehicle



## SB 1: Formulas, Set-Asides & Competitive Grants

65% of the new revenue from SB 1 will go for repair of state highways and local streets

- > 65% formula funding
- > 35% set-asides/competitive





## SB 1 projected to bring \$25.8 million to Ventura County in first full year

**For Local Streets** 

- \$9.7 million from SB 1 in FY 2017/18
- \$25.8 million FY 2018/19 (the first full year of the tax)
- Measure AA would have provided \$35 million year one





#### **Relatively Small Share for VCTC Priorities**



- Flexible Transit Funds: \$2.7 million/year new funds
- Transit State of Good Repair: \$1 million/year new funds
- STIP: \$18 million (over ten years) –
  offset by previous cuts



### **Rail Funding**

**System-Wide** 

- Metrolink: \$4 million/year
- LOSSAN: \$5 million/year
- Funds go Directly to Metrolink/ LOSSAN
  - Do not flow through member agencies







#### **Big Emphasis on Grants**

Difficult to compete with limited local match

- Active Transportation: \$100 m/year
- Transit & Intercity Rail Capital Program: \$245 m/year
- Trade Corridor Enhancement Funds: \$300 m/year
- Congested Corridors Program: \$250 m/year
- Local Planning Grants: \$25 m/year
- State/Local Partnerships: \$200 m/year

(Ventura County Ineligible)





#### **VCTC Staff Actions**

- Develop priorities for VCTC apportionments
- Work with SCRRA and LOSSAN for their apportionments
- Work with the local agencies to strategize grants
- Work with CTC, Caltrans on guidelines
- Provide periodic updates
