**VCTC Bus Service Changes Go into Effect August 19, 2019**

Ventura, Calif. – On Monday, Aug. 19<sup>th</sup>, schedule changes will go into effect for two of the [Ventura County Transportation Commission \(VCTC\)](#) Intercity bus system routes.

The Channel Islands route, formally known as Oxnard/Camarillo/CSUCI, 90, 96 and 97 will be replaced by the new Channel Islands Route 99. In addition, the Coastal Express line is adding additional service to three locations: the Camarillo Metrolink Station, The Collection and the Esplanade Mall.

"VCTC is delighted to add new service for our bus riders. The new schedule updates are just a few more examples of ways VCTC keeps Ventura County moving." said Darren Kettle, VCTC Executive Director.

The new Coastal Express stop at the Camarillo Metrolink Station will support increased multimodal connections with the commute-friendly train service that the Amtrak Pacific Surfliner offers.
