ONE (1) POSITION VACANCY FOR A CITIZEN REPRESENTING CITIES WITHIN VENTURA COUNTY.

The Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) is seeking a resident of a City within Ventura County to serve a four-year term commencing February 1, 2021 to serve on the Commission. The individual cannot be an elected official. VCTC touches virtually all transportation related issues affecting the Ventura County region. The Commission plans, funds and manages a wide array of activities designed to keep Ventura County moving.

VCTC typically meets the first Friday of every month and on occasion a second Friday when the first Friday is on a three-day weekend (except August when the Commission is dark) at 9:00 a.m. at the Camarillo City Hall Council Chambers. During the current COVID-19 pandemic Commission meetings are held via Zoom. Commissioners are asked to make themselves available until noon on meeting days. Compensation for meeting attendance or representing VCTC at a meeting is \$100.00 per meeting, with a two-meeting maximum in one calendar month.

Those residents who are interested in being considered for the position are directed to send a letter and completed application to Roxanna Ibarra, Clerk of the Commission at ribarra@goventura.org due no later than **12 noon, January 4, 2021**. The City Selection Committee of Ventura County is responsible for the appointment of the citizen to represent Ventura County cities. VCTC will compile all applications received by 12 noon, January 4, 2021 and forward to the Ventura County City Selection Committee for their consideration of an appointment.
