What is the Ventura County Comprehensive Transportation Plan?

The Ventura County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) is the long-range planning document prepared by the Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) that plans for the future of transportation in the county over the next 30 years. The CTP analyzes data, community priorities, and local transportation solutions while also placing a special emphasis on inclusion of disadvantaged and underserved communities to create a more equitable transportation future for all.



What is the purpose of the Plan?

The Plan:

- Identifies future transportation needs, priorities, and funding
- Identifies strategies to reduce emissions and improve air quality
- Enhances equitable access to mobility options
- Establishes a vision for mobility in Ventura County for the next 30 years

How will the Plan be used to improve Ventura County?

The Plan:

- Contains strategies to improve all modes of transportation
- Prioritizes future investments/projects based on community priorities
- Highlights opportunities to implement recommendations



What's the project location and scope?

The Plan includes all transportation modes throughout Ventura County, including unincorporated areas and the 10 incorporated cities, and analyzes needs for walking, biking, transit, rail, freight, airports and more.
