VCTC Releases Draft Comprehensive Transportation Plan for Community Review and Input

CAMARILLO, Calif. – The Ventura County Transportation Commission will release a draft of its Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP), a long-range planning document addressing the future of transportation in Ventura County for the next 20-30 years. The Plan will be available for review by December 2 at goventura.org/CTP, and community members are invited to provide feedback through January 10, 2023.

“We’ve heard from hundreds of community members about their concerns and desires related to transportation across our county – from the need for more and safer places to walk and bike to improved access to transit,” said VCTC Executive Director Martin Erickson. “The Comprehensive Transportation Plan envisions a more resilient and equitable transportation future for Ventura County and creates an action plan to get there. We look forward to receiving feedback on the draft plan.”

The CTP addresses five important goals:

- Balance transportation and land use
- Reduce emissions and improve sustainability
- Foster economic prosperity
- Improve multimodal mobility choice & access to destinations
- Improve design to eliminate traffic deaths & improve safety

The December 6 virtual community workshop will be hosted on Zoom, and Spanish interpretation will be provided.
