


#### Ventura County Commuter Mode Split











- Allows for funding of additional projects




Unconstrained project list – includes projects without identified funding

- Trade-off: magnitude of VMT reduction vs traffic delay change














 Small improvements in mode split  Larger changes require more land use/transportation integration












## **ACCESS TO ADDITIONAL FORMS OF TRANSPORTATION**
