



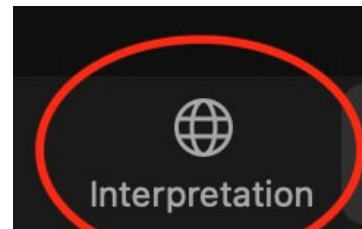

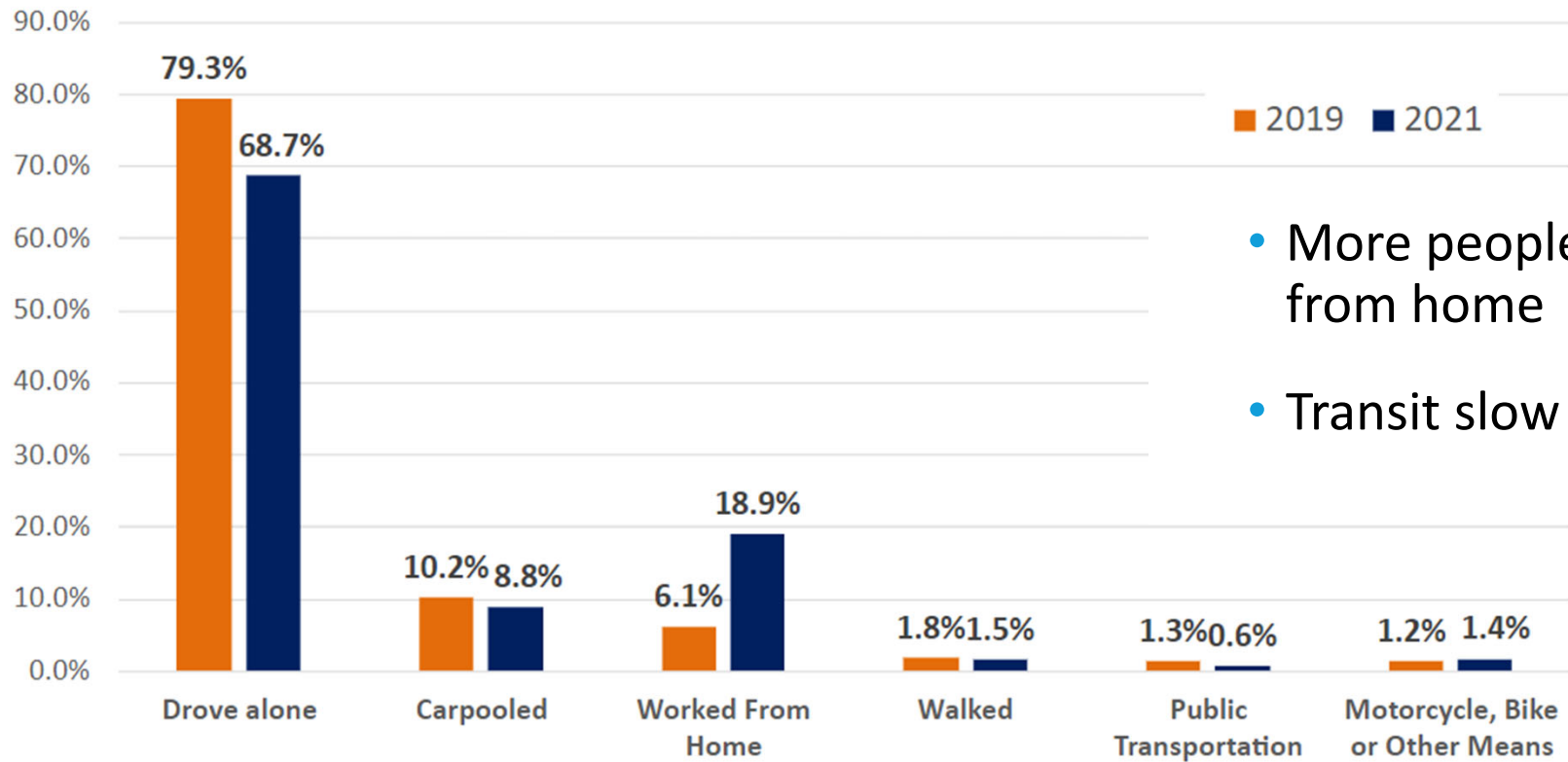

- Transit slow to recover

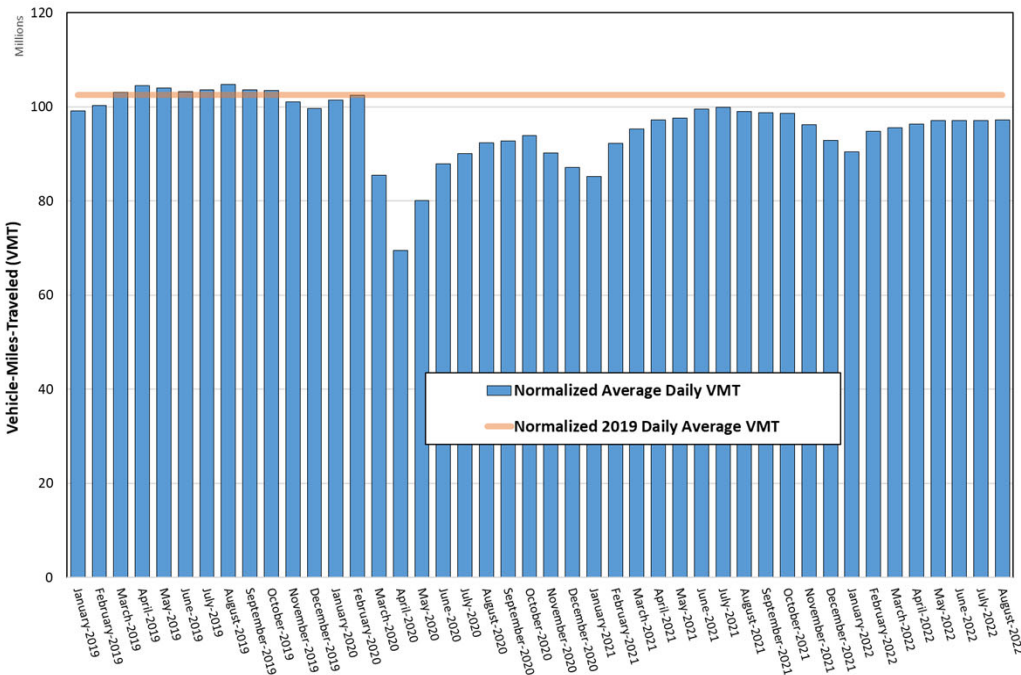

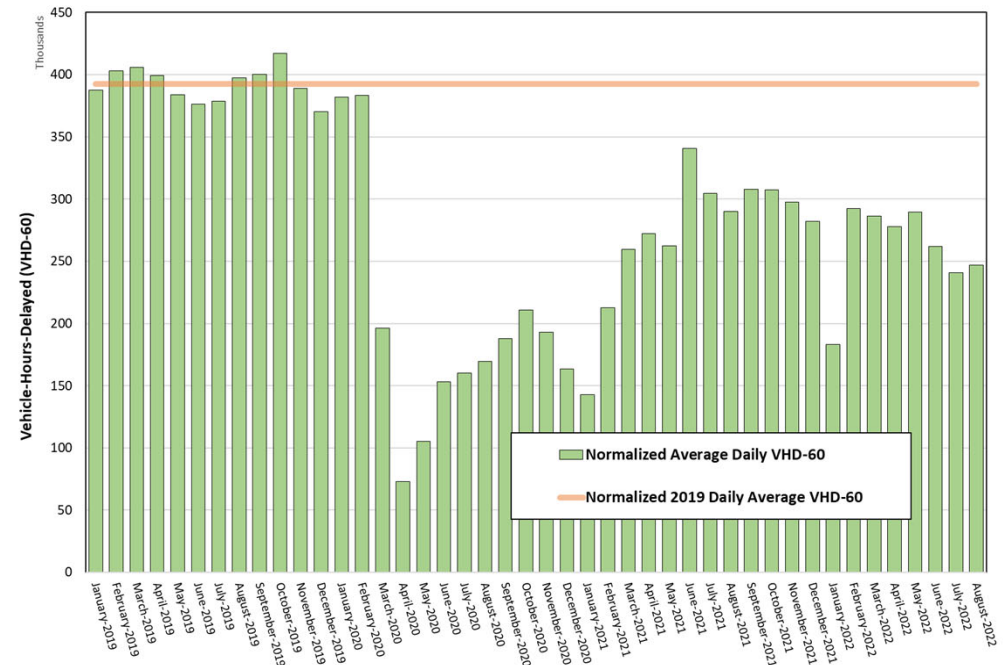


VENTURA COUNTY COMMUTERS

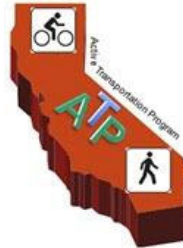

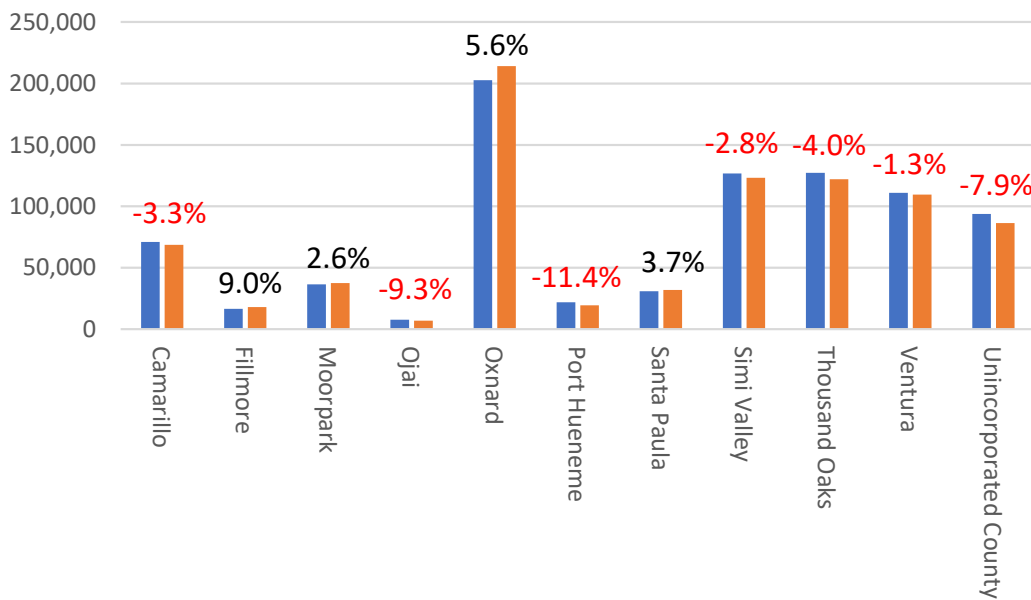

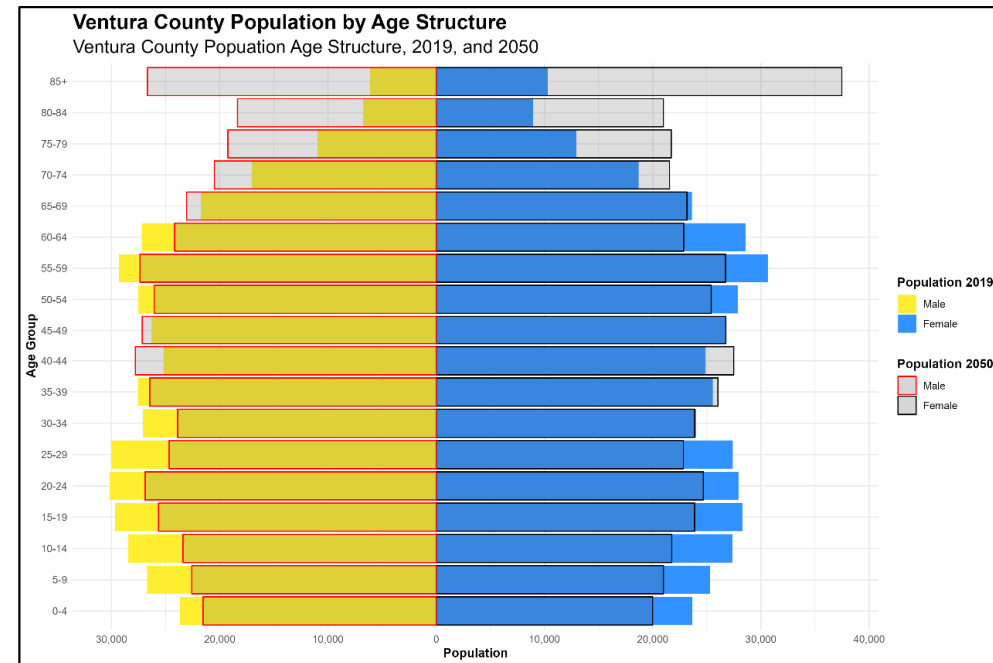
- Slowing population growth

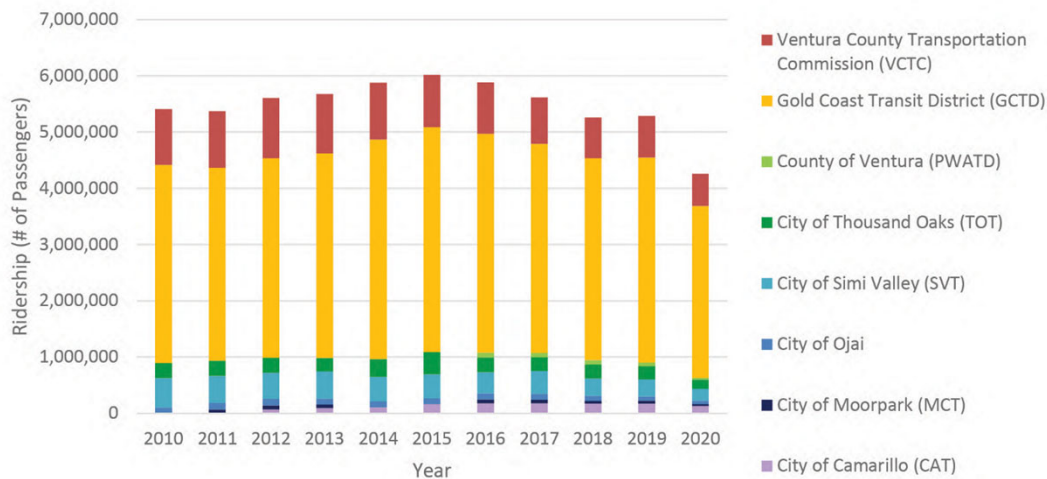

- Limited local transportation funding



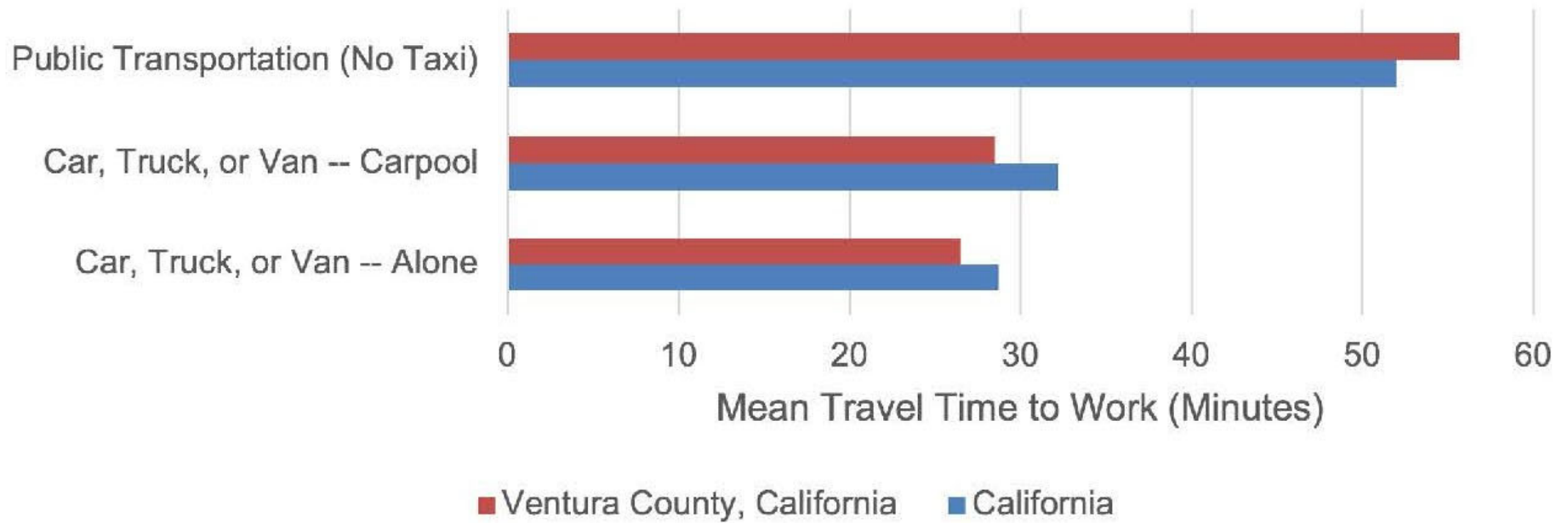

- Virtual community meeting

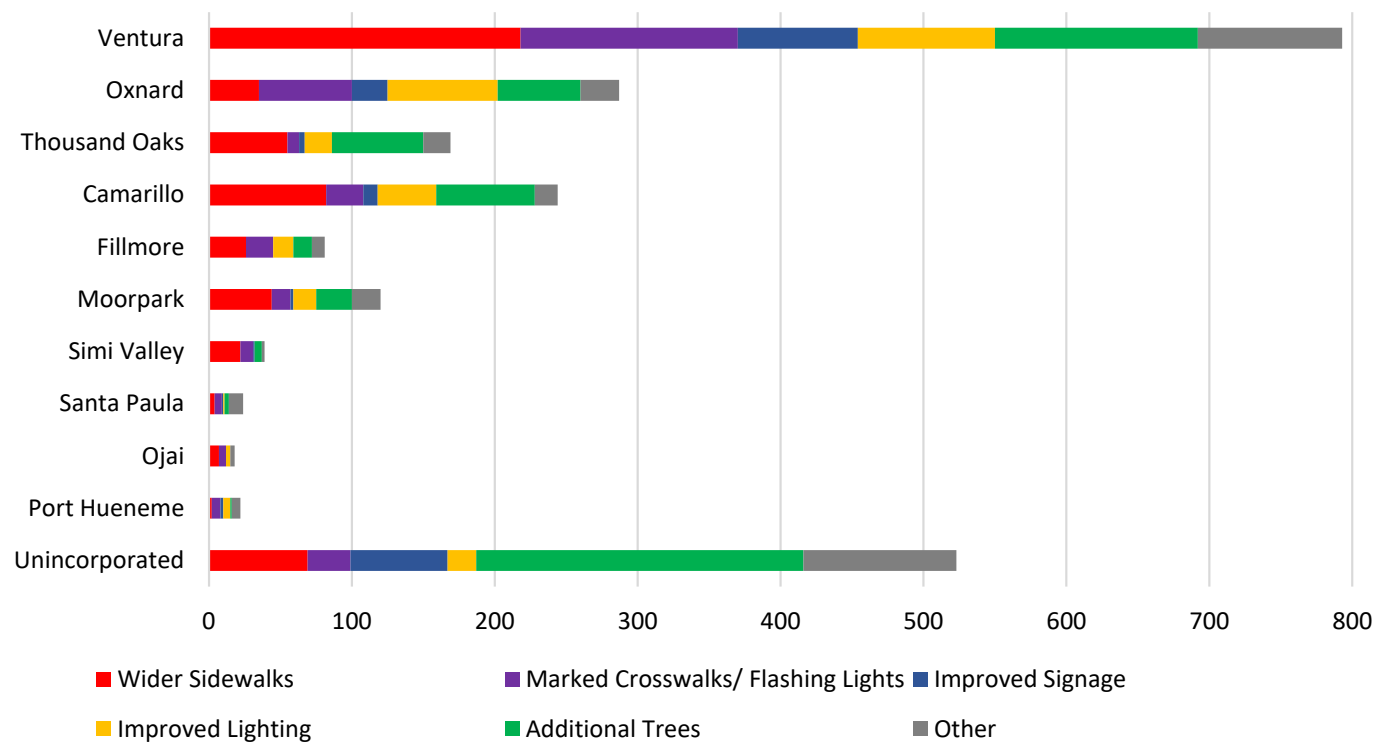

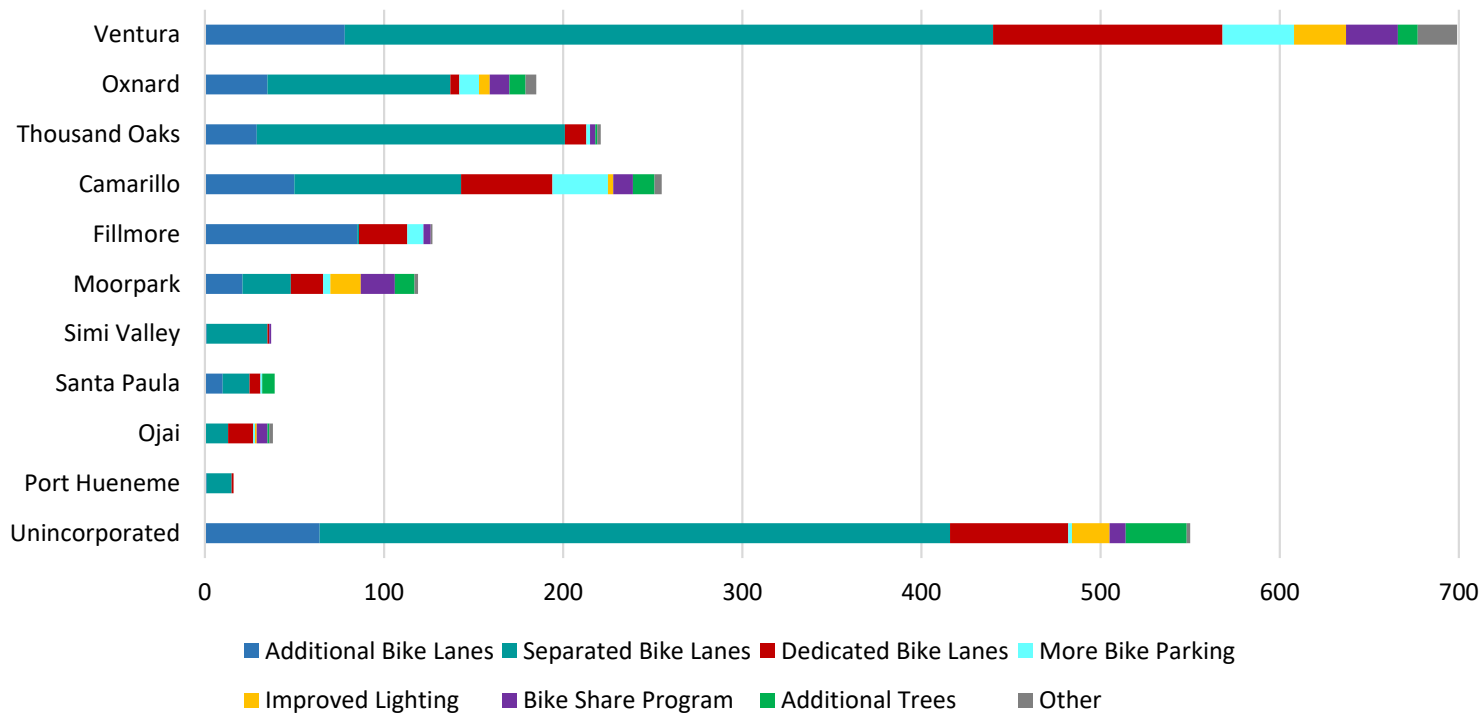

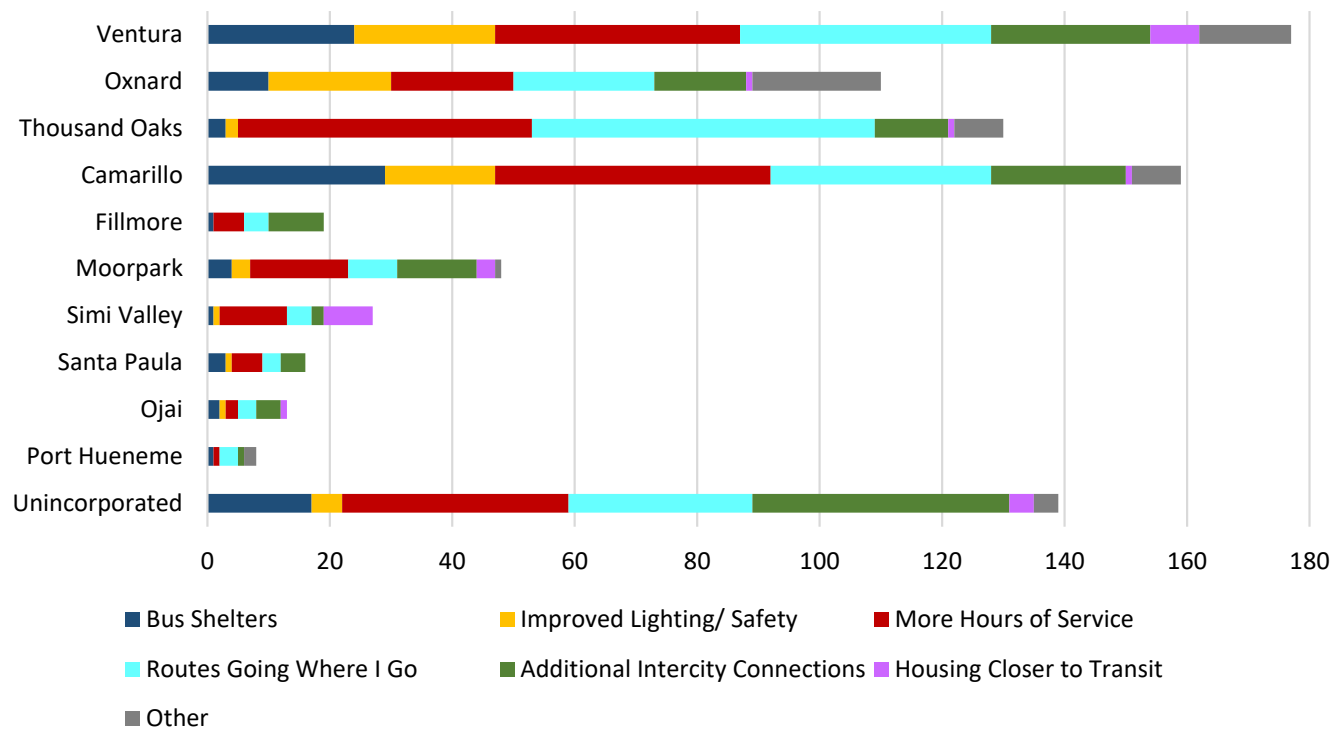

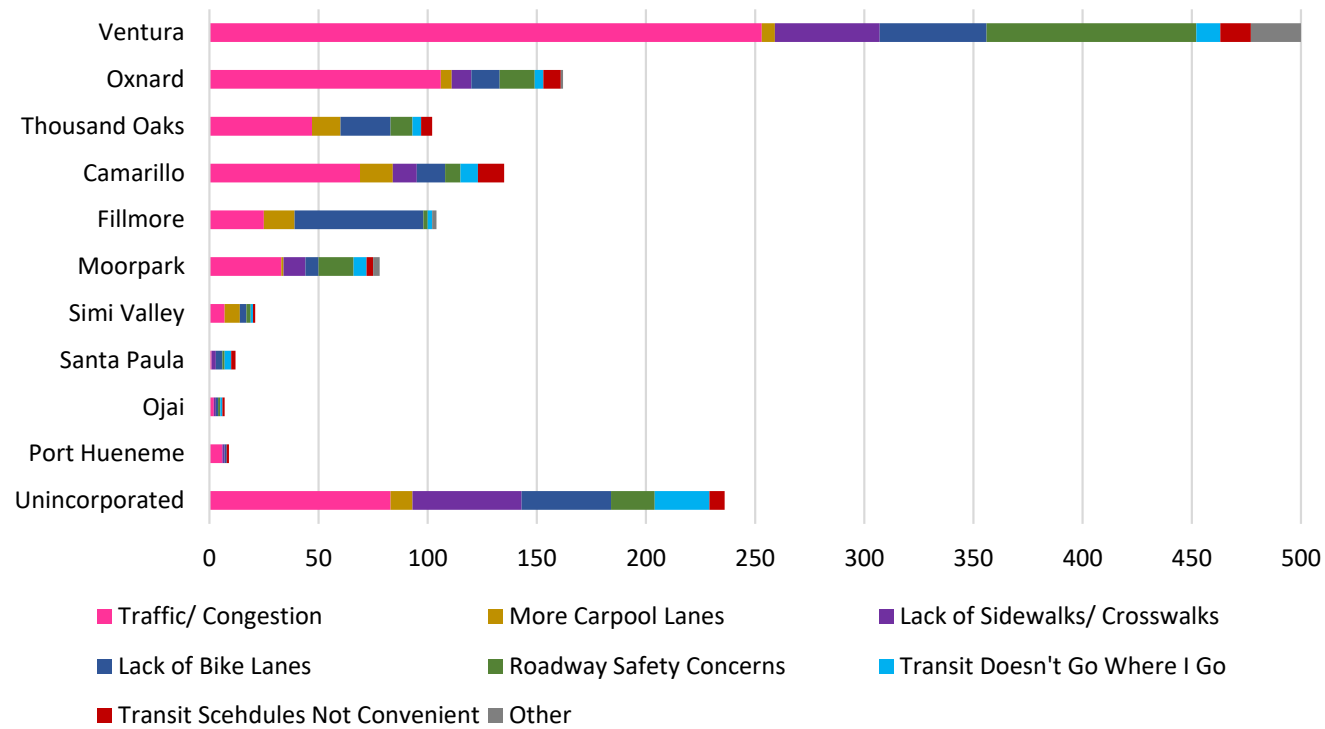

FUTURE SCENARIOS

Scenario A

- Currently planned and programmed (funded) projects
- Traditionally available levels of funding in Ventura County

Scenario B

- Assumes new local funding source for transportation
- Allows for funding of additional projects

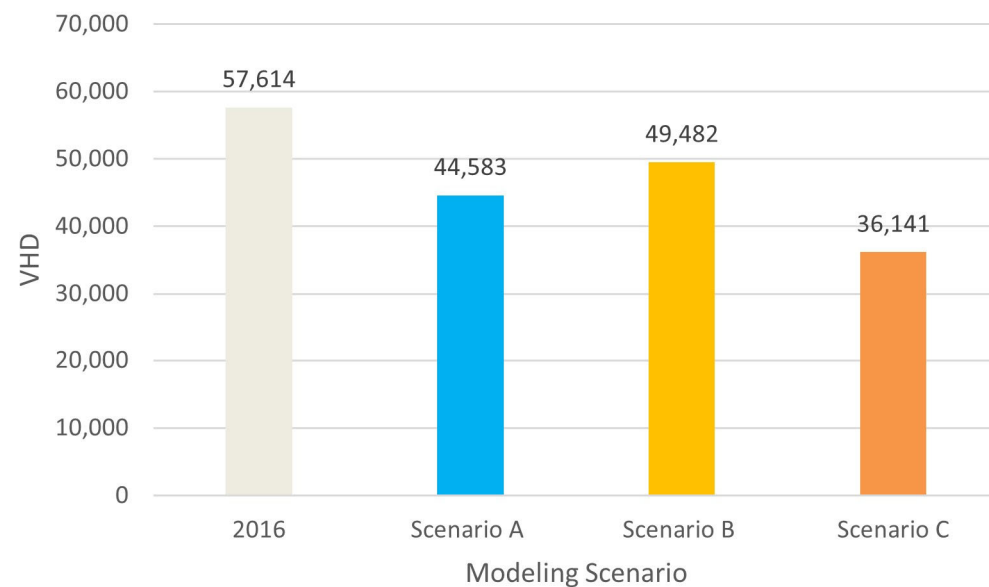
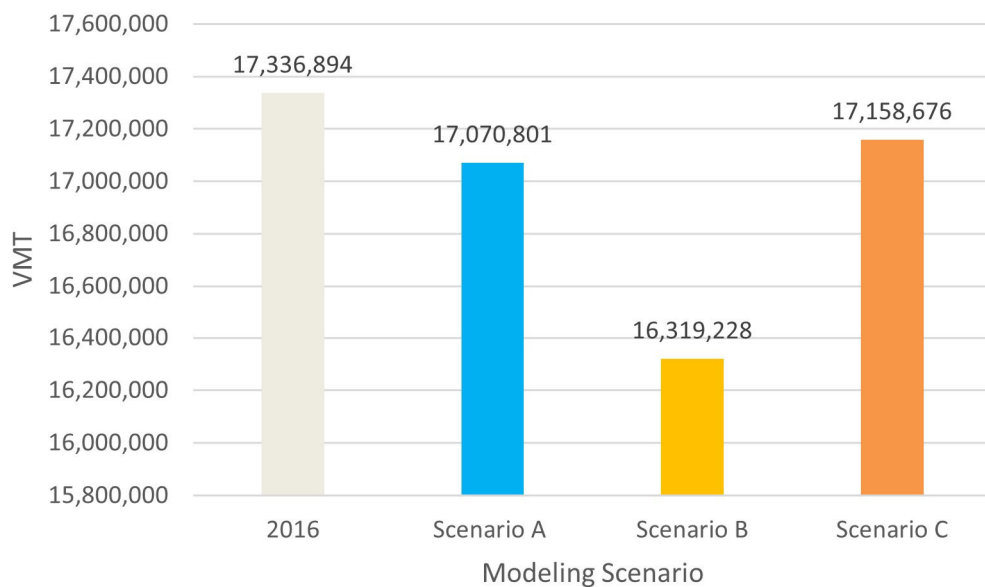
Scenario C

- Unconstrained project list – includes projects without identified funding



SCENARIO PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

- Overall reduction in VMT
- Overall reduction in traffic delay
- Trade-off: magnitude of VMT reduction vs traffic delay change

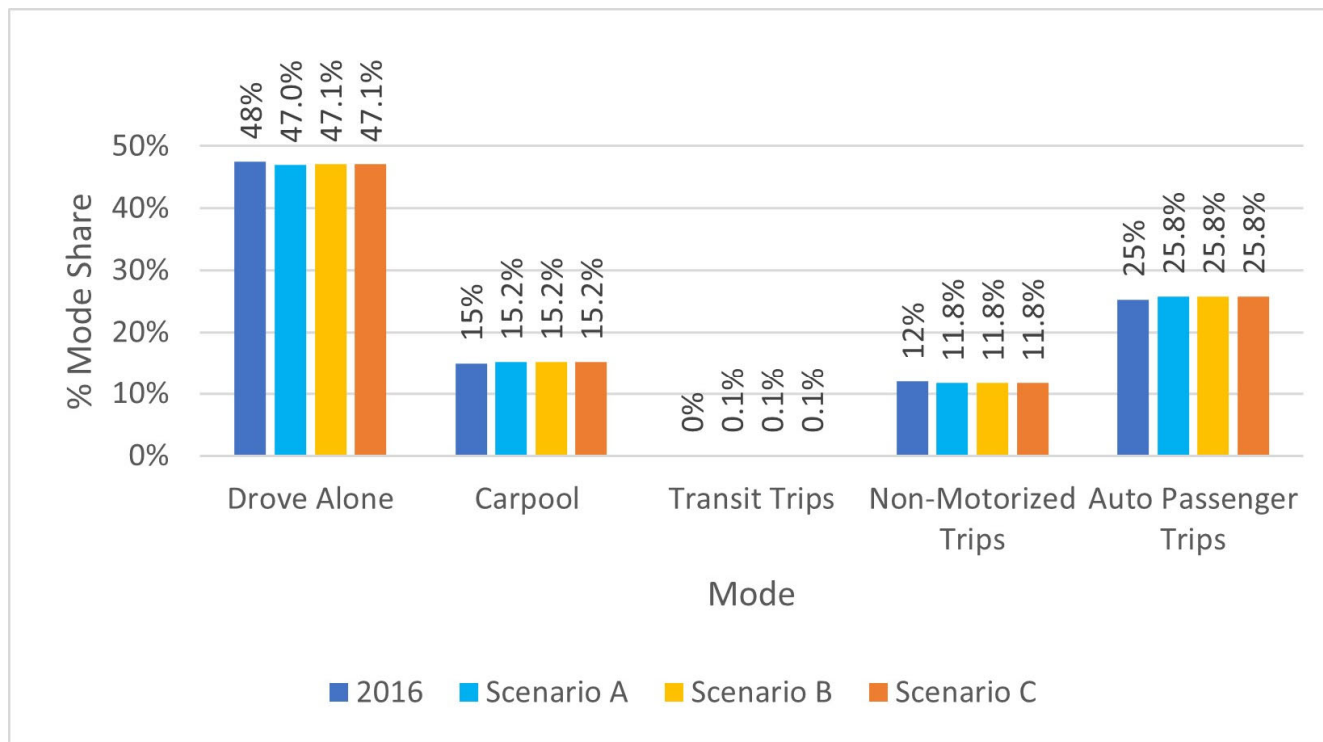

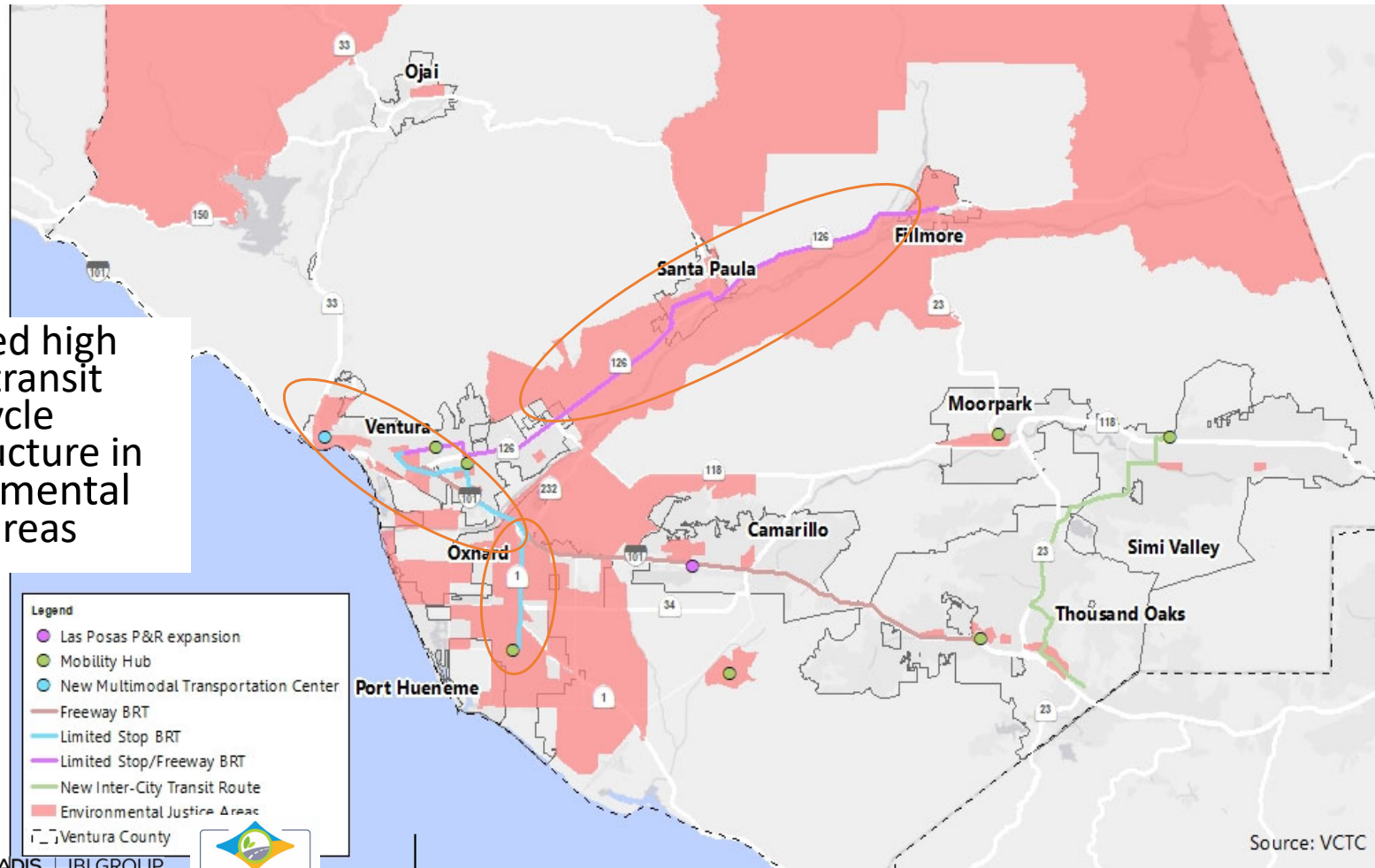
SCENARIO PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

- Small improvements in mode split
- Larger changes require more land use/transportation integration



SCENARIO PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

- Expanded high quality transit and bicycle infrastructure in environmental justice areas

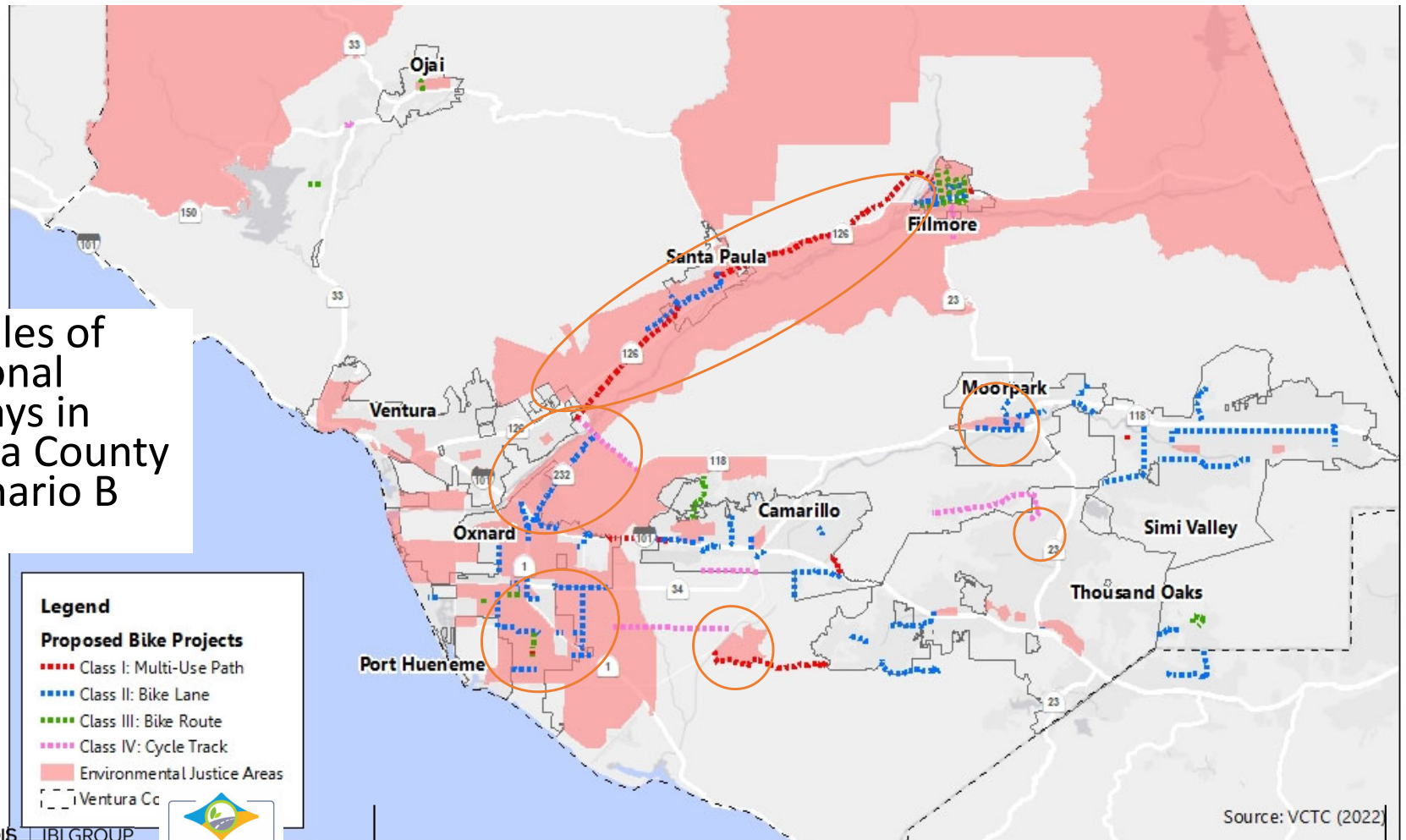

- 115 miles of additional bikeways in Ventura County in Scenario B

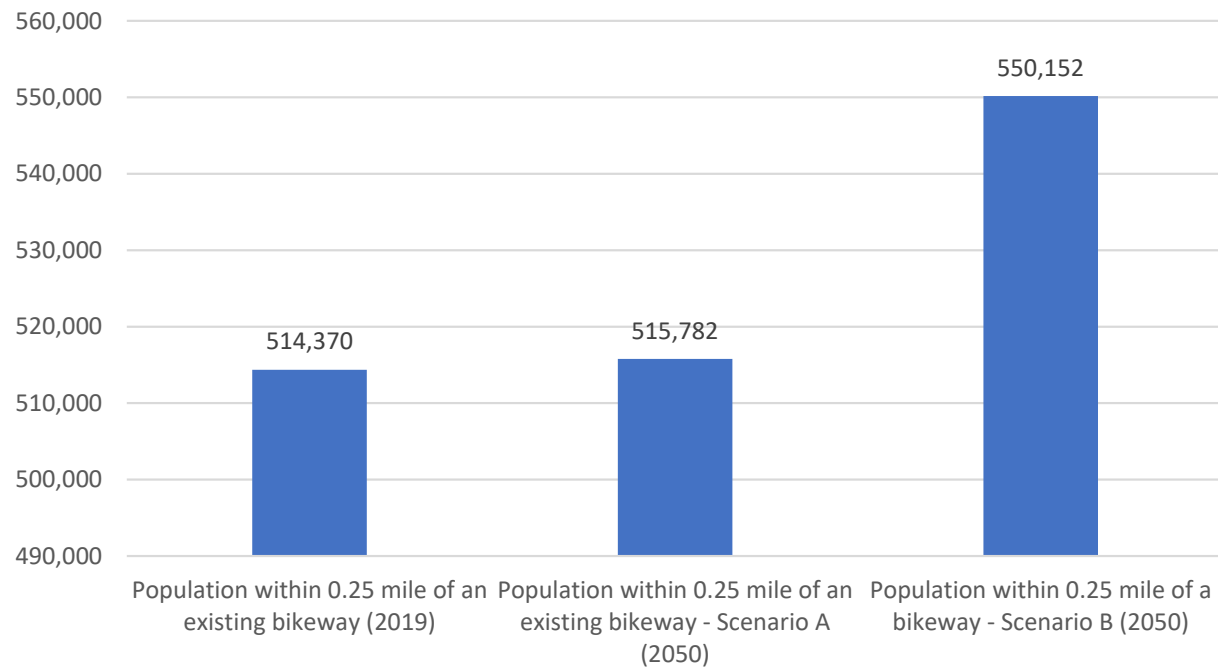

- Population within 0.25 miles of a bike facility

- Continue local agency coordination and local project implementation
- Pursue additional funding opportunities

Regional Issues

- Continue regional planning cooperation – 2024 RTP/SCS, LOSSAN corridor, US 101 HOV PA&ED
- Enhance partnerships with Port of Hueneme and NBVC
