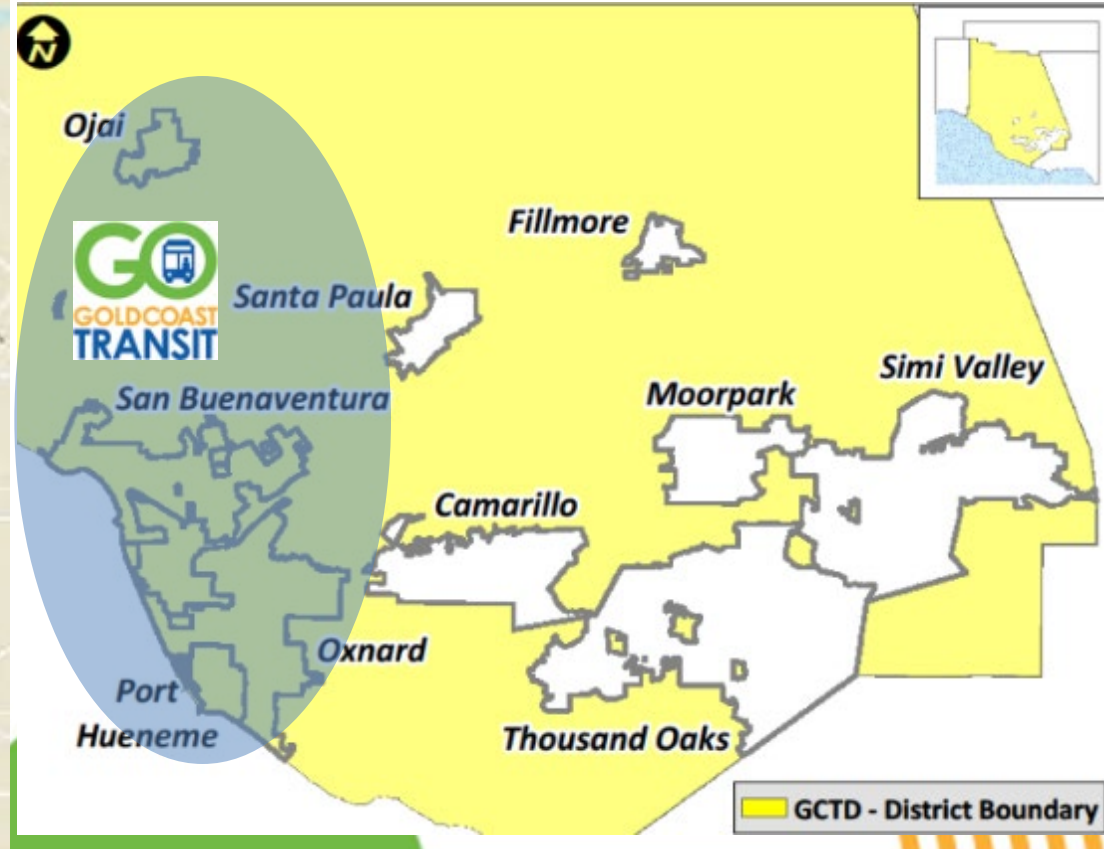
- GCTD provide technical input to City Planning Depts

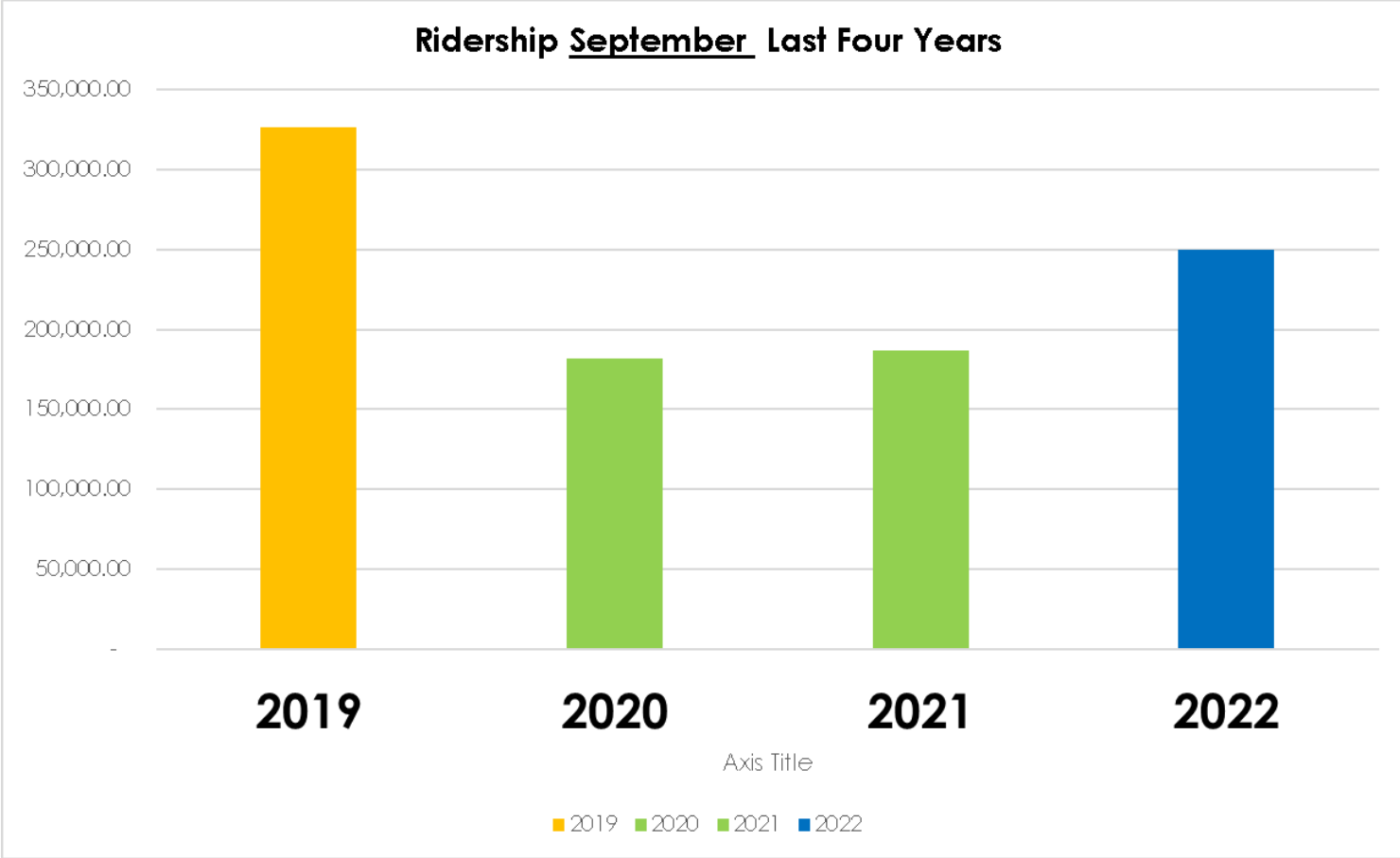

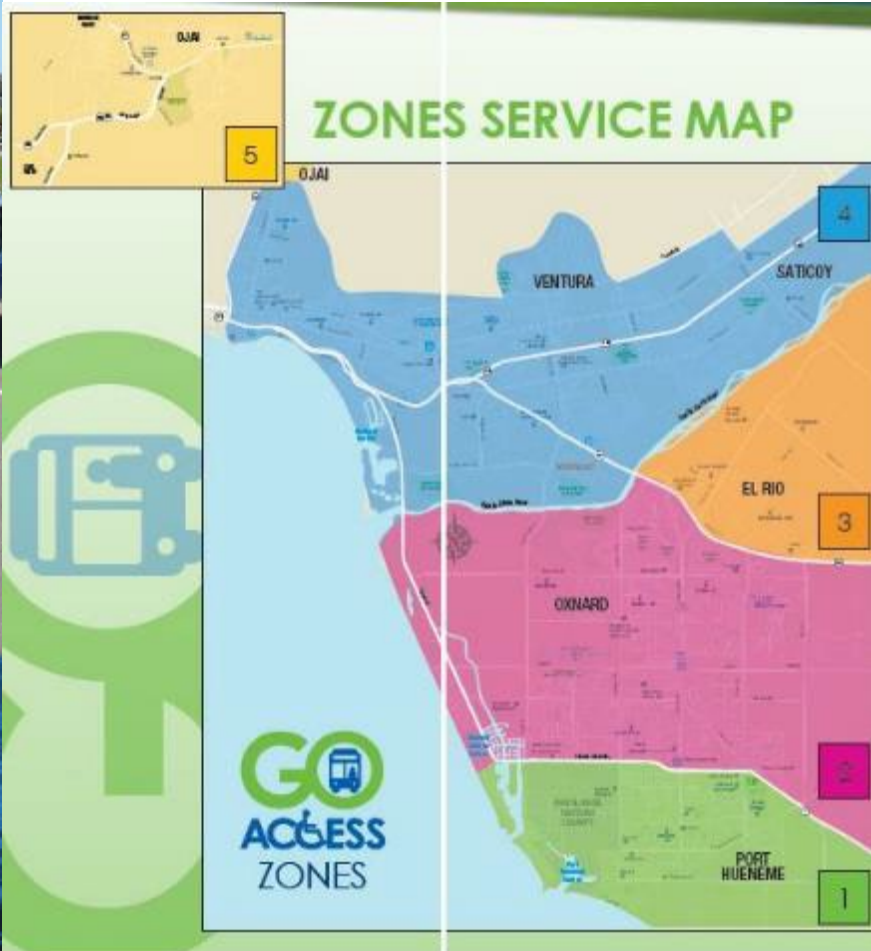

ZERO emissions

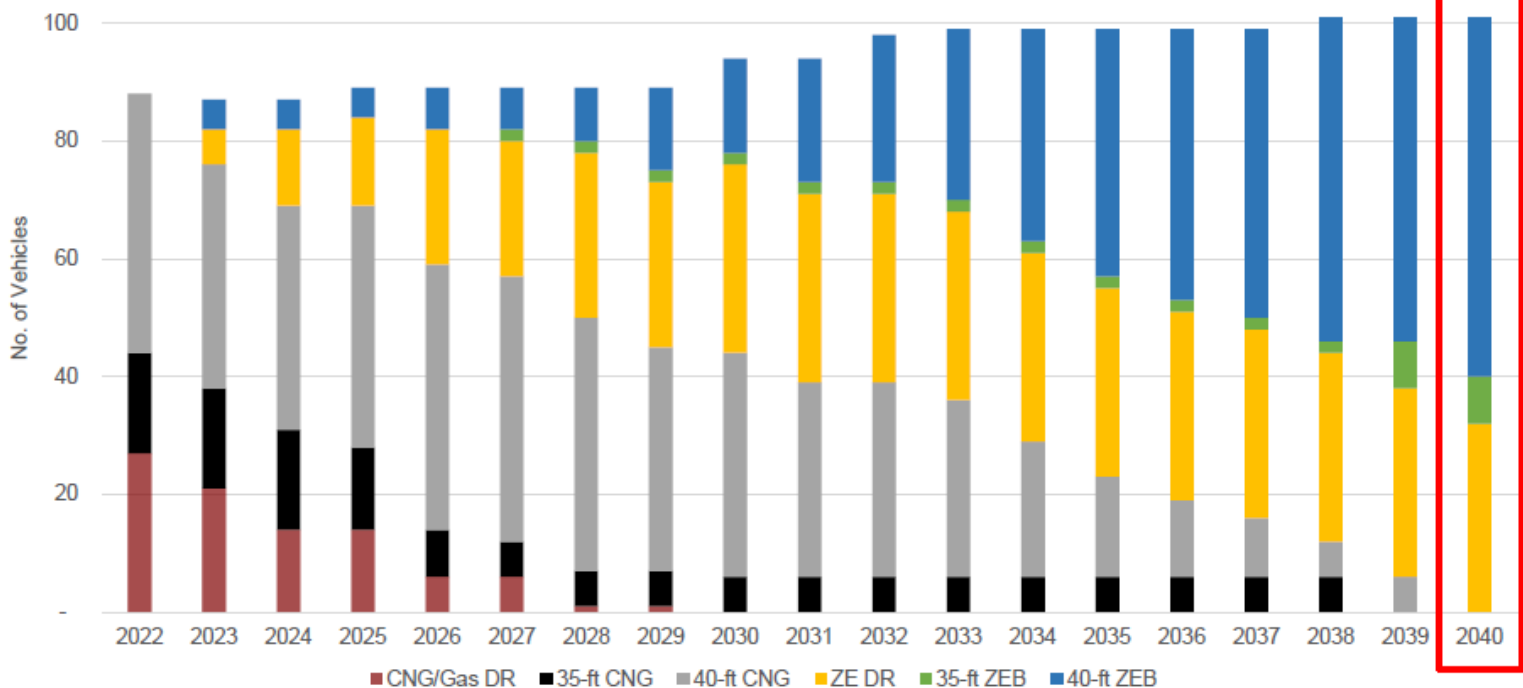


- In 2018, California Air Resources Board (CARB) “Innovative Clean Transit” Rule
