Unmet Transit Needs

What is the Unmet Transit Needs process and Why?

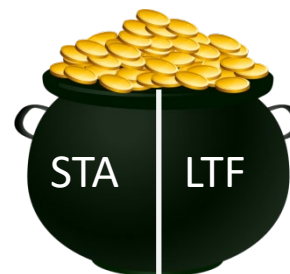
- It is part of the process in allocating TDA funds

Transportation Development Act (TDA) Funding to Ventura County



State Transit Assistance Fund (STA)

- Statewide revenues from gas and diesel tax
- Distributed by geographic pop. to counties

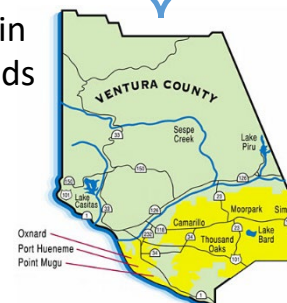


Local Transportation Fund (LTF)

- ¼ cent of statewide sales taxes
- Distributed by geographic pop. to counties



TDA law governs the prioritization in which Counties distribute their funds





Unmet Transit Needs

Applicable to cities with Population 100K or less, not in GCTD service area:

- Camarillo
- Fillmore
- Moorpark
- Santa Paula
- And by separate statute, Thousand Oaks





Unmet Transit Needs

- **Unmet needs definition:** New service or Expanded service
- An item must meet the 15-comment threshold for fixed-route service and 10-comment threshold for dial-a-ride service in order to be considered an unmet need
- **Reasonable to Meet criteria:** a service request is considered reasonable if passes muster of adopted criteria, including enough vehicles available, the service won't cause reductions in existing service, a transit vehicle can safely navigate the streets, among others
- If service is instituted, farebox is evaluated using the passenger fare ratios in the reasonable to meet criteria (the ratios are compliant with TDA statute)

- Coastal Express extended to Camarillo

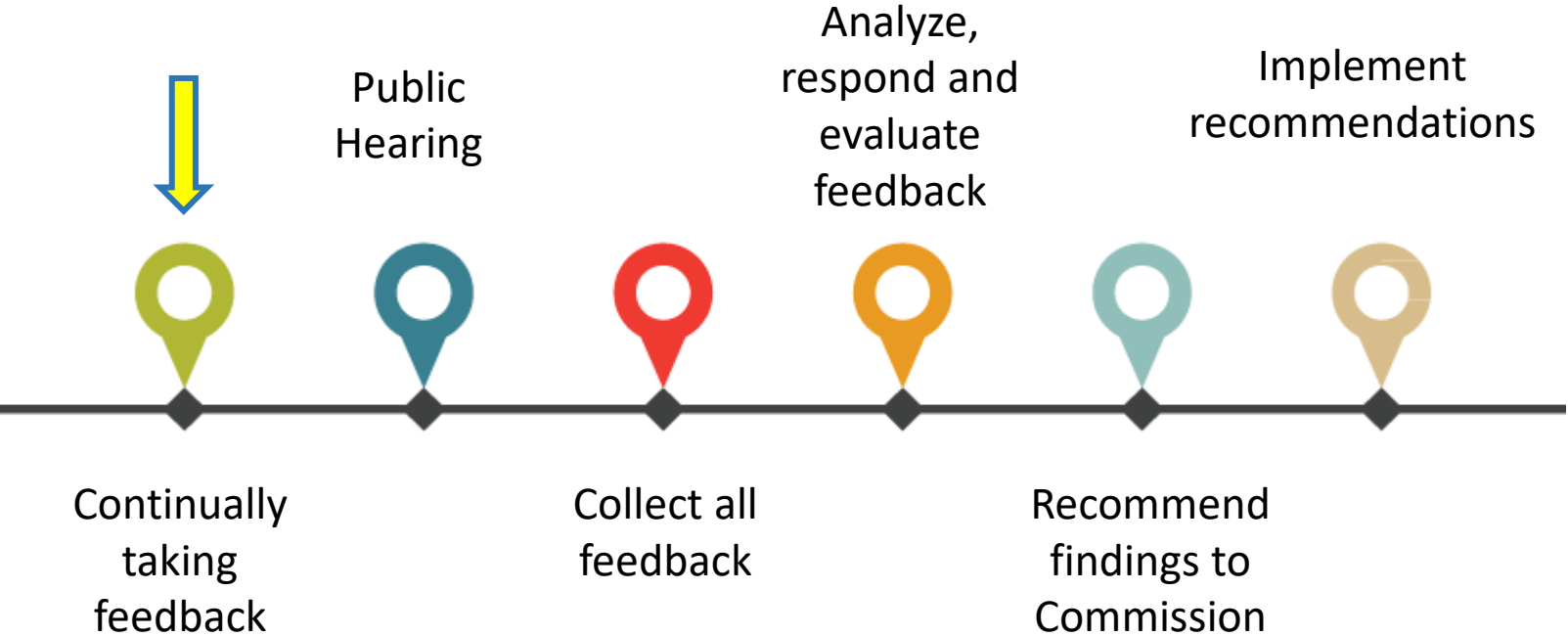


- Stop Improvements
