  A: No there is no preferred font type or size for the proposal.

A: Page 10 reporting requirements should also include, but not be limited to, for STA audits, a Schedule of Status of Fund by Project as applicable.

4. Will VCTC confirm if the proposal should say that there is no new Prop 1B funding being provided to agencies and that Simi Valley's Prop 1B funds were to be utilized by June 30, 2023?

A: At this time, VCTC is unaware of any new Proposition 1B funding and Simi Valley is the only agency that still has Proposition 1B funding to expend and be audited. The Simi Valley Proposition 1B audit has not been completed at the time of the RFP issuance and VCTC is not aware of any additional extensions at this time.

5. Under General Proposal Requirements (page 6) it states that facsimiles, emails and electronic media shall NOT be accepted as submittal of printed copies. But can we email you the electronic copy of the proposal, in addition to sending you the electronic copy via usb?

A: The proposal should be submitted as five (5) printed copies with an electronic pdf copy via usb.
