# Arroyo Simi Bridge Barrier Project

- Nearly 6,500 feet of safety fencing
- Construction set to begin on October 27
- Overnight construction will minimize traffic impacts
- 95 total working days over 5 months

Most work will occur Monday to Friday, with some weekend activity if necessary. Traffic may be reduced to one lane in each direction.

Weekdays: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Saturdays: 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Sundays: 8 p.m. to 9 a.m.
